



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Montclair City Council on Monday, August 3, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM video/teleconference (meeting link: <https://zoom.us/j/93717150550>) concerning the following:

1. **Resolution No. 20-3281** adopting Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) thresholds for the purpose of analyzing transportation impacts under the California Environmental Quality Act in accordance with the requirements of Senate Bill 743.
2. **Ordinance No. 20-989** related to imposing a one percent District No. 2 Transactions and Use Tax to be administered by the State Board of Equalization if approved by the voters at the November 3, 2020 General Municipal Election.

INVITATION TO BE HEARD: All interested persons will be given an opportunity to comment on these items at the public hearing and any subsequent public hearings conducted related to these items. In addition, written comments may be submitted to the City Council prior to the hearings, to the attention of City Clerk's Office, City of Montclair, 5111 Benito Street, Montclair, California, or may be sent via email to cityclerk@cityofmontclair.org. Please reference the hearing title and date of hearing in any correspondence. If you wish to challenge any of the above items in court, the challenge will be limited only to those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing(s) in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearings as described in this notice.
