NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, February 16, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom video/teleconference (meeting link: <https://zoom.us/j/95239872725>), the City Council of the City of Montclair will conduct a public hearing concerning Ordinance No. 21-995 amending Section 8.36.090 of the Montclair Municipal Code to eliminate commercial truck parking on Brooks Street and Palo Verde Street.

Please reference the hearing title and date of hearing in any correspondence.

If you wish to challenge any of the above items in court, the challenge will be limited only to those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearings in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearings as described in this notice. The City cannot be held responsible for U.S. Mail that is not received prior to the hearings.
