Re: Meeting to discuss proposed Fremont & Arrow Highway Streetscape project

Dear Resident:

The City of Montclair has obtained funding for streetscape enhancements for Arrow Highway between Monte Vista Avenue and Central Avenue, and for Fremont Avenue between Arrow Highway and Moreno Street.

The proposed project includes providing two through traffic lanes in each direction on Arrow Highway with a raised landscape median in the center, allowing left turns at selected locations. The project will also include establishing street trees along each edge of the street, and protected parallel parking stalls on each side of the street. Sidewalks will remain on each side of the street.

Fremont Avenue enhancements will result in the roadway being narrowed to provide one traffic lane in each direction, and parallel parking on each side of the street. Street trees lining both sides of the street will be provided, as will sidewalk and pedestrian scale lighting. The project will include four designated pedestrian crossing locations across Fremont Avenue.

City staff would like to invite you to meet with the design team to learn more about the project, ask questions, and provide input to the design of the enhancements. A meeting to discuss the project has been scheduled for August 20, 2019 at 6:00 pm in the Senior Center at 5111 Benito Street.
