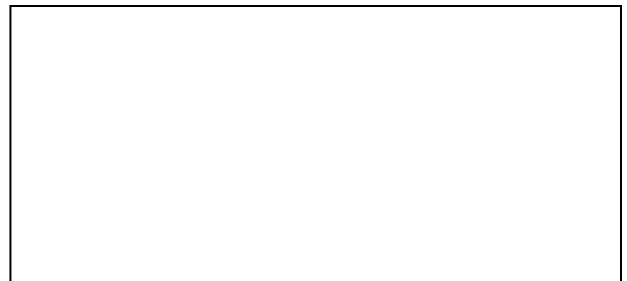

## ALARM SYSTEM PERMIT INFORMATION

On January 3, 1983, the Montclair City Council unanimously passed Ordinance No. 82-547, codified as Chapter 11 of Title 4 of the Municipal Code which addresses the incidents of false robbery and/or burglar alarms.

Historically, false robbery and/or burglar alarms have hovered at the 97-percentile range, which creates a tremendous drain of police patrol services. This Ordinance will place alarm users under permit and subject them to a reasonable service fee for excessive false alarms.

Provided is some brief information regarding the contents of the Ordinance.

**YOU SHOULD READ THE ATTACHED ORDINANCE FOR COMPLETE INFORMATION.**

An Alarm System is equipment arranged to signal the presence of a hazard requiring police attention.

“Premises” shall mean any building or group of units within one building.

To have an “alarm system”, a person shall get a permit from the Department of Administrative Services, Business Licensing Division.

Alarm permits shall be revoked if: permittee fails to observe the regulations; alarm system emits more than six false alarms in any 365-day period; or false representation was made on any application.

There is currently a \$50.00 false alarm service fee for the fourth and each subsequent false alarm annually.

Revocation of permits may be appealed to the City Council.
